Dear [Redacted],

We have important information to share with our customers who plan to install rooftop solar systems.

On June 1, 2016, we filed a proposal with the Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) to change how our rates are structured. If approved, these changes could impact future rooftop solar customers, but **you will not be impacted.**

We have proposed that current rooftop solar customers be “grandfathered” for 20 years. Though your solar system is not yet tied to the electrical grid, we have proposed a way for you to still be eligible for grandfathering if you meet the following criteria:

- Your signed installer contract and your interconnection application, including all required design documents, are accepted by APS by July 1, 2017
- Your system is installed within 180 days of reservation approval

Although you will not be impacted, you may be wondering why we are asking for this change.

Our customers have benefitted from solar energy since the 1950s when we first brought solar to Arizona, and we are committed to keeping it as a part of our energy mix. But to achieve a sustainable energy future, it’s important that we support solar the right way. And that means putting a structure in place that makes solar energy as cost-effective, reliable and efficient as possible, while making sure its benefits are shared by all customers.
